



Beautiful Snowy Mountain Scenery at “Terrace of Frost Tree”

Enjoy Frost Trees from the New “Cloud Bar”

Dates: December 1st, 2019 - April 5th, 2020

Hoshino Resorts TOMAMU, the highest quality snow resort hotel in Hokkaido, will offer “Terrace of Frost Tree” from December 1st, 2019 to April 5th, 2020. This terrace has beautiful views of the snowy mountains, and guests will be able to enjoy the “frost tree” phenomenon, where temperatures ranging from 2 to 10 degrees below zero cause the moisture and fog in the air to settle on trees and plants. This year, visitors are also invited to view the frost trees from the new “Cloud Bar”, newly opened in the summer of 2019. The frost trees will also be lit up at night for a limited time.



What is the “Terrace of Frost Tree”?

“Terrace of Frost Tree” is a terrace located at an elevation of 1,088 meters on Mt. Tomamu, where visitors can witness the beautiful sight created by frost settling on the trees. Since people tend to associate mountains as places for skiing or snowboarding, Hoshino Resorts TOMAMU will open “Terrace of Frost Tree”, so that people who do not enjoy skiing or snowboarding can still experience the beauty of the mountains. After the sun sets, guests are invited to view Nighttime Frost Tree Light Up, first held in 2017. During the activity, visitors can enjoy beautiful illuminations of trees that sparkle like gemstones. The resort aspires to provide guests with the incredible mountain scenery created by these frost trees.



Three attractions to enjoy at “Terrace of Frost Tree”

1. Enjoy the frost trees from the newly opened “Cloud Bar”

“Cloud Bar”, opened in the summer of 2019, is an observation spot designed to look like a bar counter. Located on the same mountain slope as “Terrace of Frost Tree”, three meters off the ground and with a counter thirteen meters long, there are one and two-person seats available, for a total capacity of seven people. Since there is nothing blocking the view, it is truly a front-row seat experience where visitors can feel like they are floating, having the frost trees right by their feet.



2. Enjoy cocktails and desserts at “Terrace of Frost Tree”

At “Terrace of Frost Tree”, there will be original cocktails on offer that reflect the snowy Tomamu scenery, including the Snow Cocktail, Frost Tree Chocolate Fondant, and Frost Tree Coffee.



3. The Nighttime Frost Tree Light Up

For a limited time, the resort will light up the observation spots at “Terrace of Frost Tree” such as the “Cloud Walk” and “Cloud Bar”, as well as the footpath. Visitors can observe the lit-up frost trees from several different angles. The sparkling frost trees covered in lights can only be seen during night. Visitors can fully enjoy the beauty of frost trees as they take on a distinctly different look from their daytime appearance.

Hours: 8 am - 3 pm (last gondola boarding from the station at the base of the mountain), 3:30 (last gondola boarding from the mountaintop station), 3 pm (last order)

Fee: Gondola (both ways) – Adults: ¥2,200; elementary school students: ¥1,300 (both incl. tax)
